

Reef Bean Bag Cover Instructions

What's in the box:

• 1 x bean bag cover with built-in fabric funnel

What else you'll need:

- Bean bag filling approx. 360 litres of 3–5mm diameter beads
- A second person (highly recommended)
- A large open space to contain any spills
- Optional: A large scoop or jug to help control the pour
- A paperclip to open and close the safety zipper

1. Prepare the area:

Choose a clean, open space with minimal airflow. Turn off fans or heaters — bean bag filling is extremely lightweight and can scatter easily.

2. Position the cover:

Place the bean bag cover upright with the funnel opening facing up. Unzip the main opening fully to reveal the sewn-in funnel.

3. Open the filling bag carefully:

If your filling comes in a sealed plastic bag, cut a small hole in one corner to control the flow, rather than opening the entire bag.

4. Start filling:

One person should hold the bean bag steady and keep the funnel open.

The second person slowly pours the filling into the funnel in small amounts.

Take your time to avoid spills and overfilling.

5. Shake and adjust:

Occasionally shake or pat the bean bag to help the filling settle evenly into all areas.

6. Check the fullness:

Stop filling once the bag feels firm but still has some give when you sit on it. Overfilling can make the bag too hard and put stress on the seams.

7. Close the zip:

Tuck the fabric funnel inside and zip the cover closed.

Important: Use a **paperclip** to open or close the child-safe zipper, then **remove the paperclip immediately** after use.

warning: Children can suffocate if bean bag filling is swallowed or inhaled. Do not let children climb inside this bean bag. A bean bag is not a safe sleeping surface for an infant under 12 months of age.

The zipper tabs on this product have been removed to prevent opening by children. Use a paper clip to open zippers on bean bag Remove paper clip after closing zipper.

DO NOT PLACE THIS PRODUCT NEAR AN OPEN FLAME OR RADIATOR AT ANY TIME.
