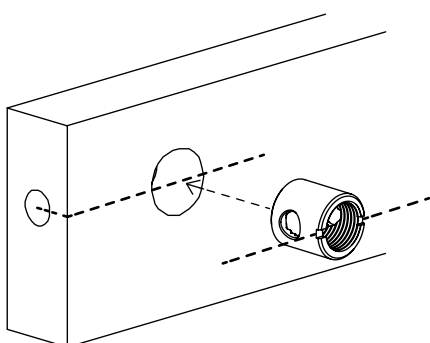
# CAM LOCK FITTING GUIDE

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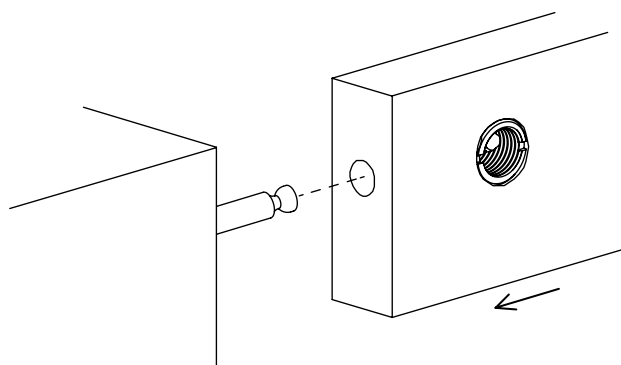
- 1.** Remove grub screw.



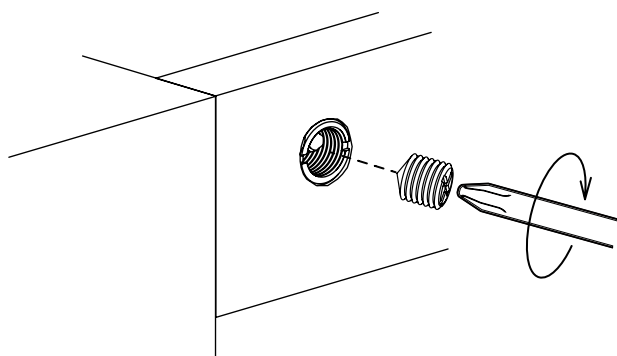
- 2.** Align the slot of barrel with the hole on side.



- 3.** Fit component.



- 4.** Tighten grub screw.



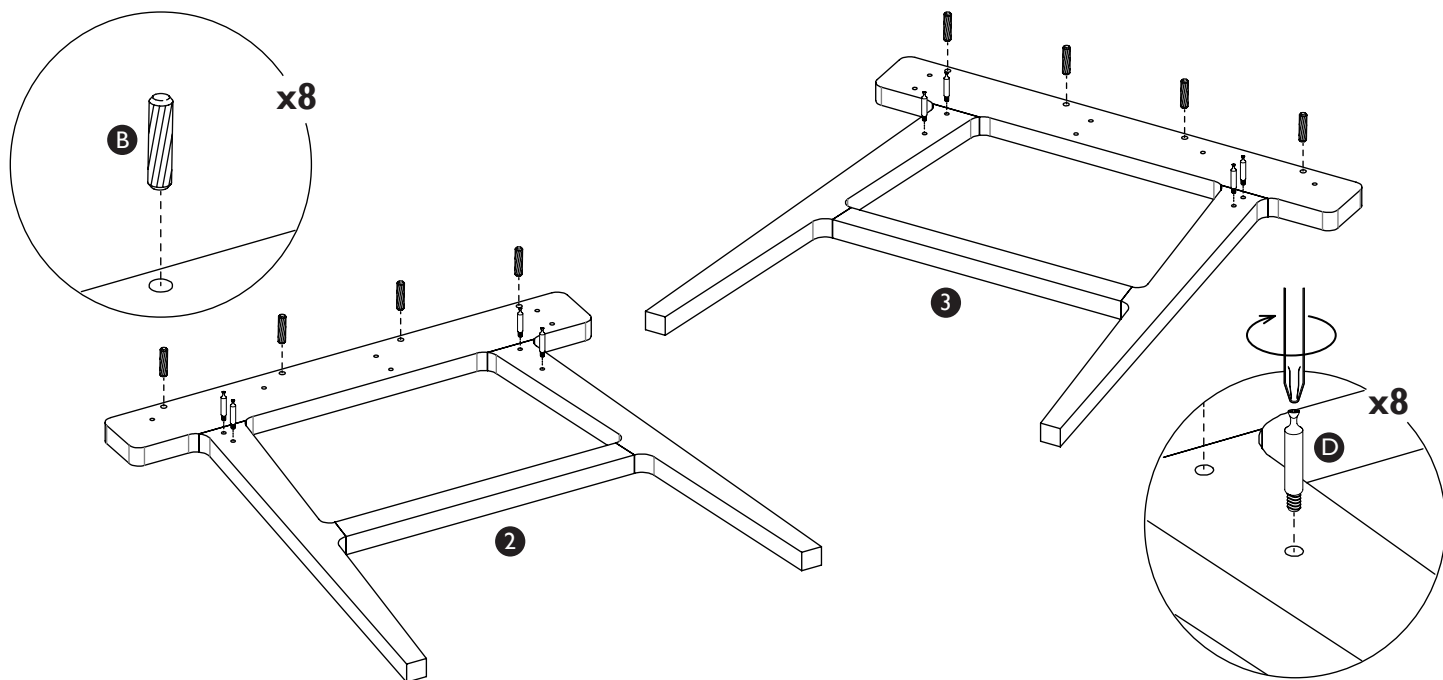
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## Step by step assembly instructions

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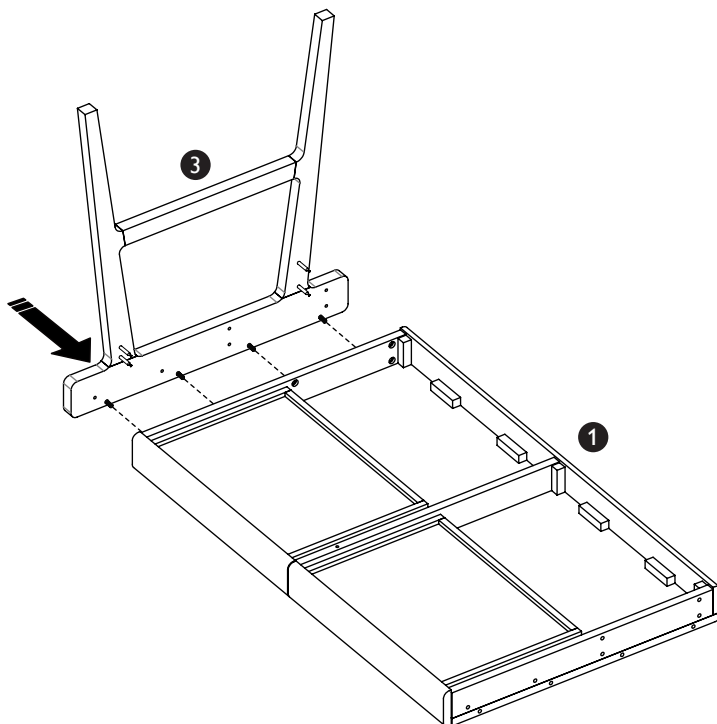
### Step 1

Carefully place the leg frames (Part 2 and Part 3) onto a soft, flat surface near where the unit will be used as shown below. Screw 8x connecting studs (Part D) into the threaded plug using a screwdriver (not included). Then insert 8x wood dowels (Part B) into the hole of each leg frame as shown below.



### Step 2

With 2 people, carefully place the table top assembly (Part 1) upside down as shown below on a soft, flat surface near where the unit will be used. Carefully locate the right leg frame (Part 3) with 4x wood dowels (Part B) that were already assembled in Step 1 as shown below.



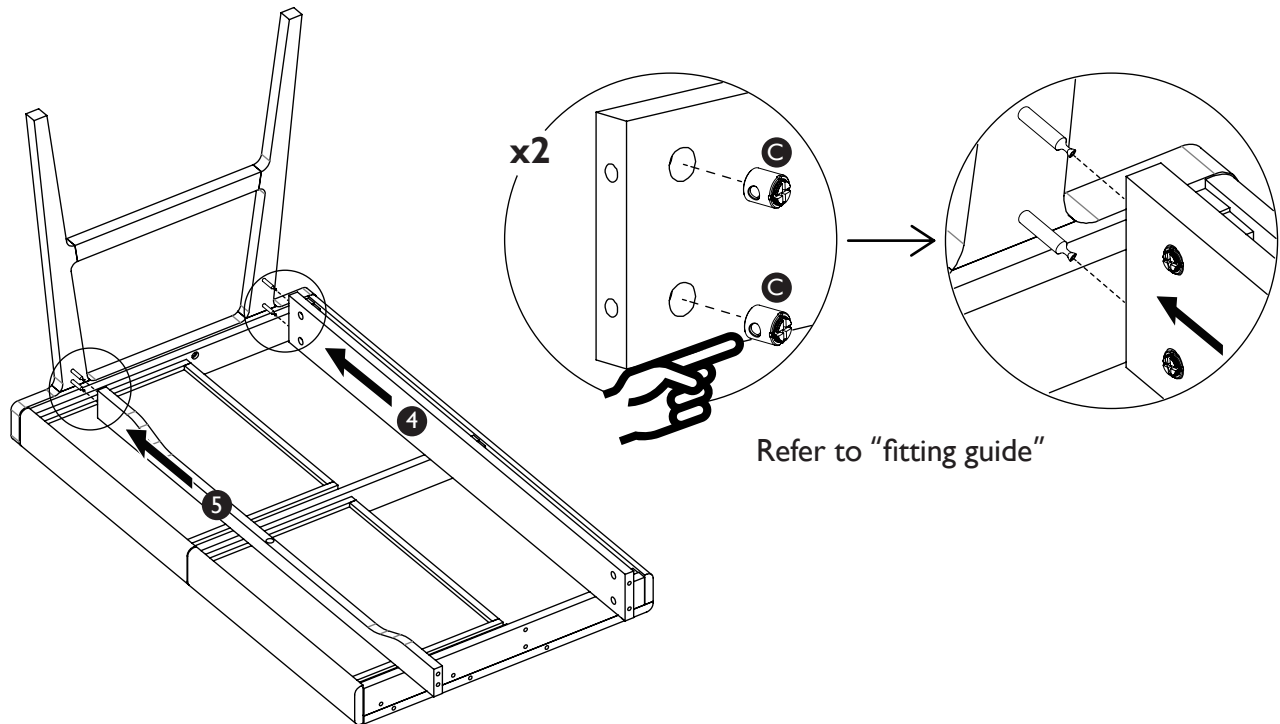

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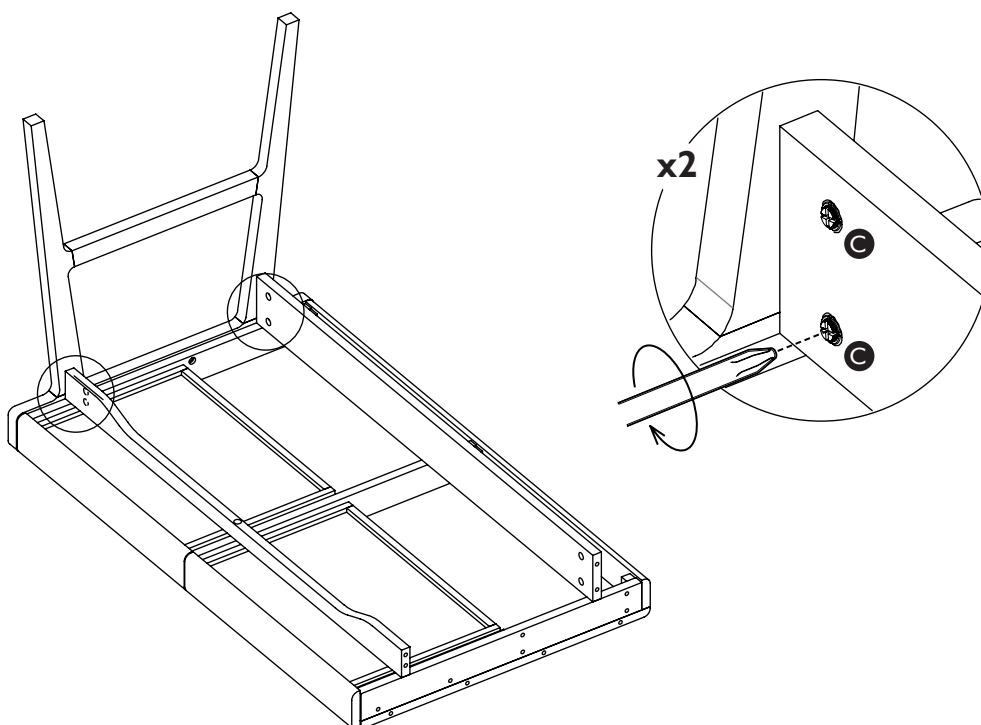
### Step 3

Insert 4x cam locks (Part C) into the holes inside of the back rail and front rail (Part 4&5) making sure the cam lock is positioned **in the correct direction** so that the connecting stud can slide into the cam lock, as shown below. Insert them over the connecting stud (Part D) that were already assembled in Step 1, as shown below.



### Step 4

Turn the cam locks (part C) in a clockwise direction using a screwdriver(not included) until they are fully tight, as shown below.



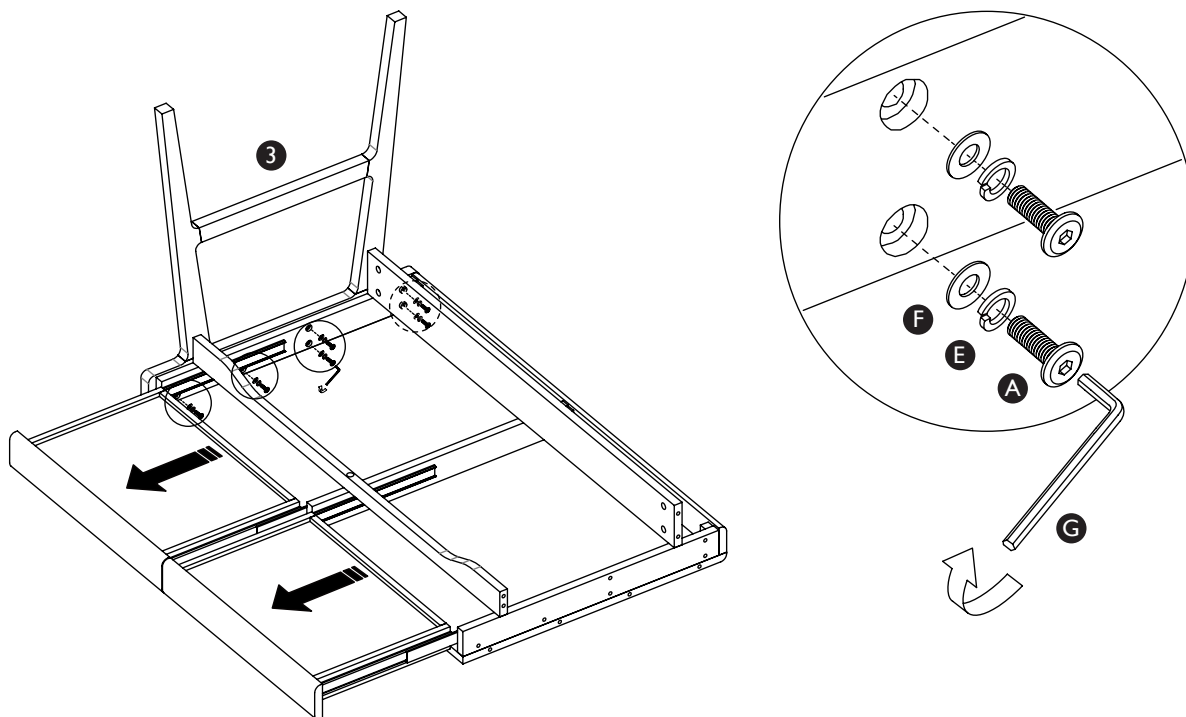

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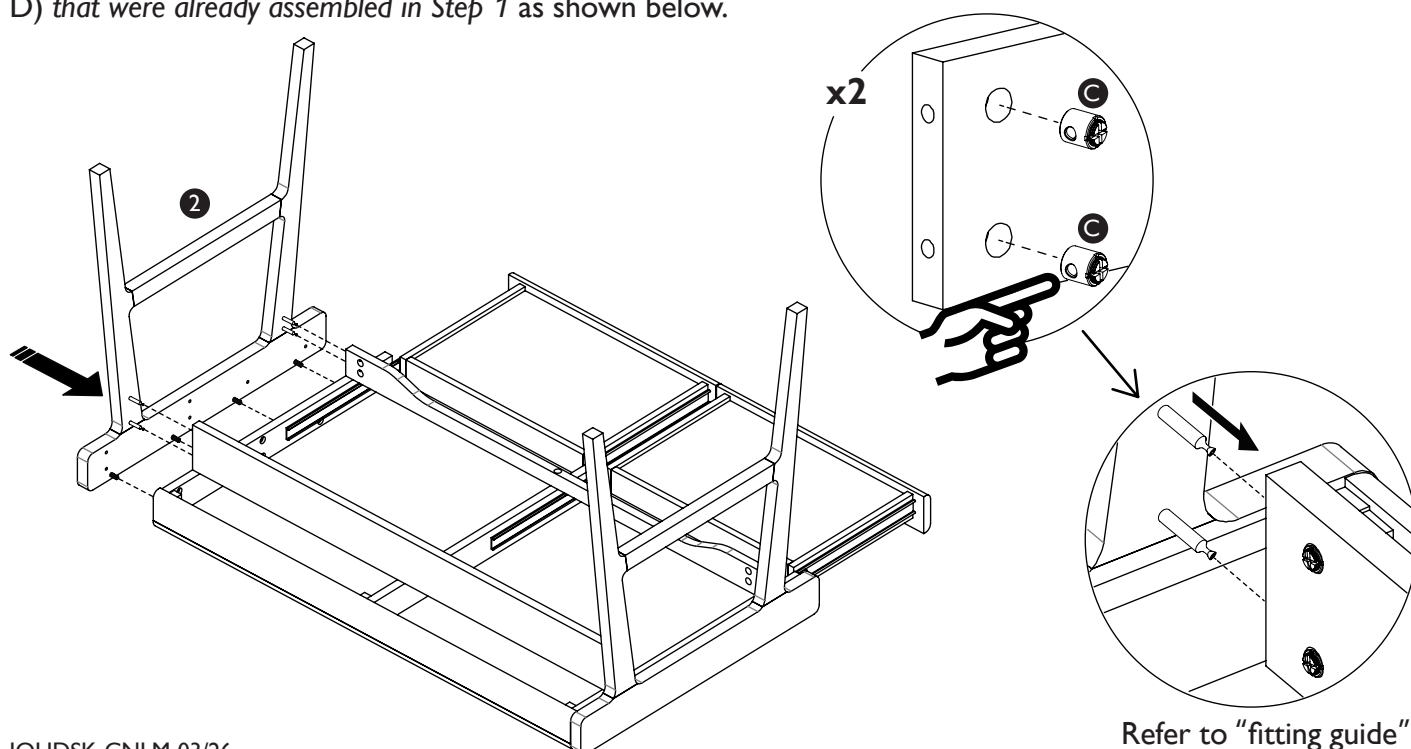
### Step 5

Secure the right leg frame (Part 3) as shown below using the bolt (6x Part A) with spring washer (6x Part E), flat washer (6x Part F) and allen key (Part G).



### Step 6

Insert 4x cam locks (Part C) into the holes inside the back rail and front rail (Part 4&5) making sure the cam lock is positioned **in the correct direction** so that the connecting stud can slide into the cam lock, as shown below. Carefully locate the left leg frame (Part 2) with 4x wood dowels (Part B) and 4x connecting studs (Part D) that were already assembled in Step 1 as shown below.



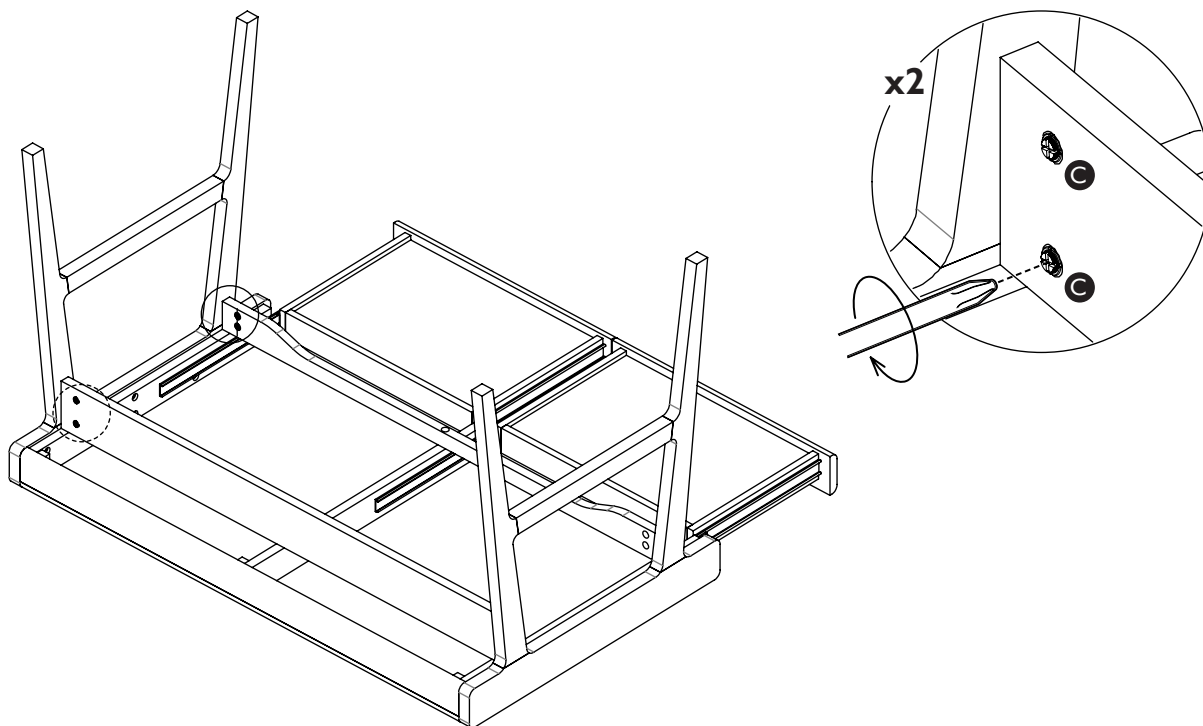

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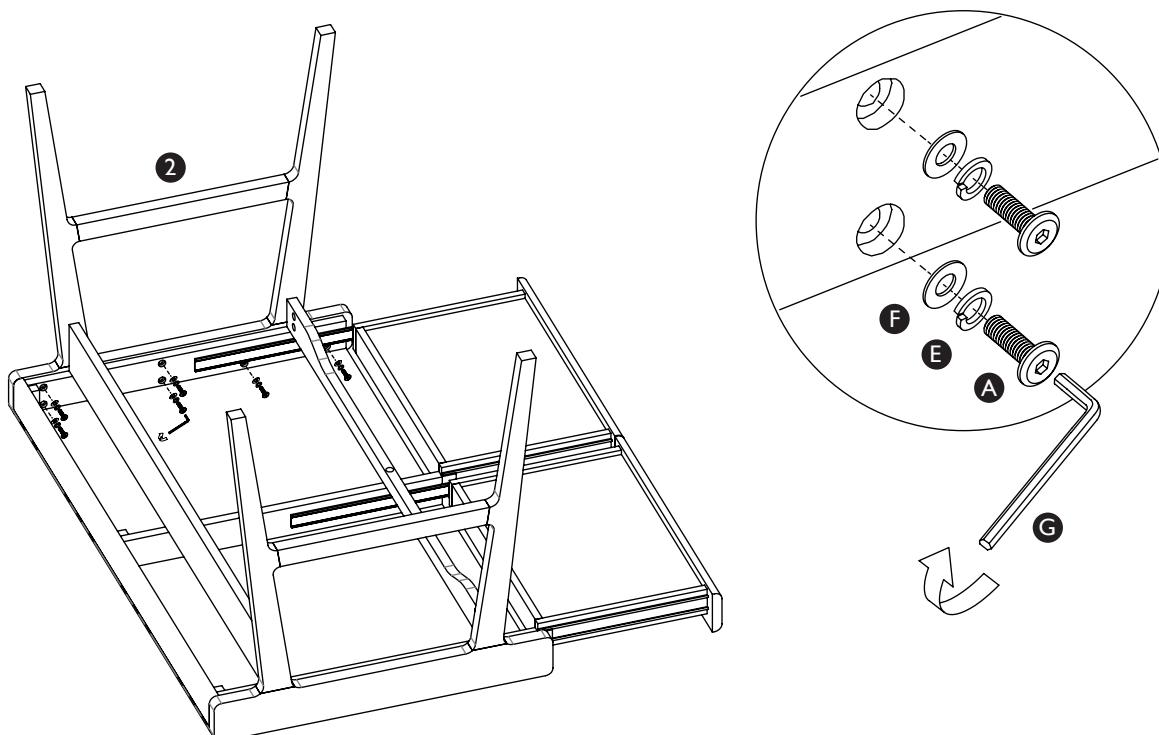
### Step 7

Turn the cam locks (part C) in a clockwise direction using a screwdriver(not included) until they are fully tight, as shown below.



### Step 8

Secure the left leg frame (Part 2) as shown below using the bolt (6x Part A) with spring washer (6x Part E), flat washer (6x Part F) and allen key (Part G).

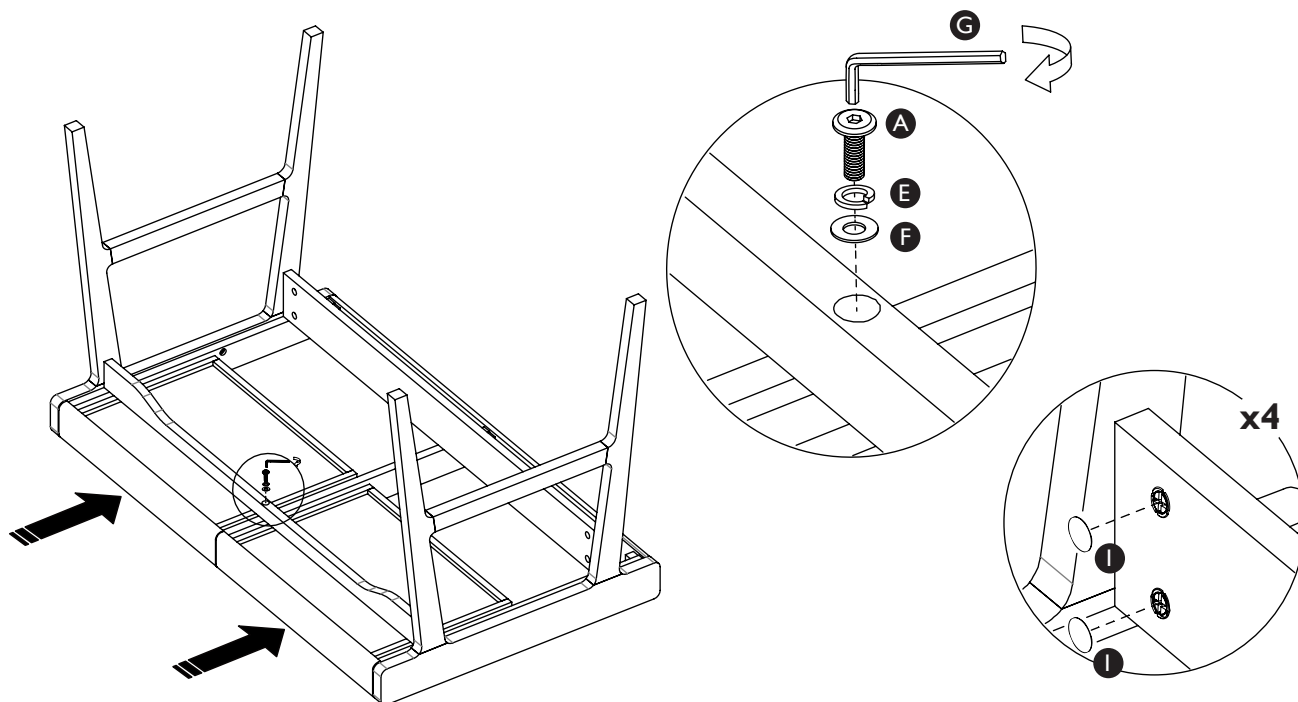


## Step by step assembly instructions

### Step 9

Secure the front rail using the bolt (Part A) with spring washer (Part E), flat washer (Part F) and allen key (Part G), as shown below.

Then attach 8x self-adhesive cam cover stickers (Part I) to cover all cam lock (Part C) as desired.

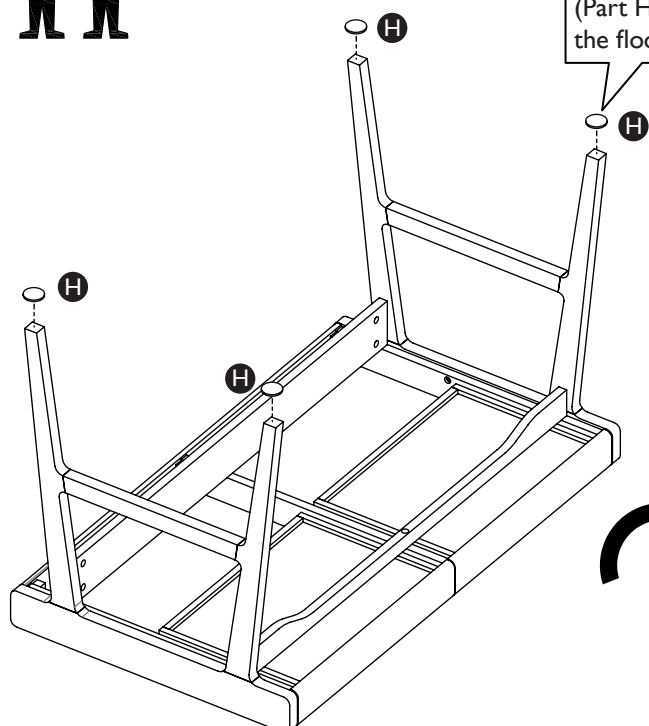


### Step 10

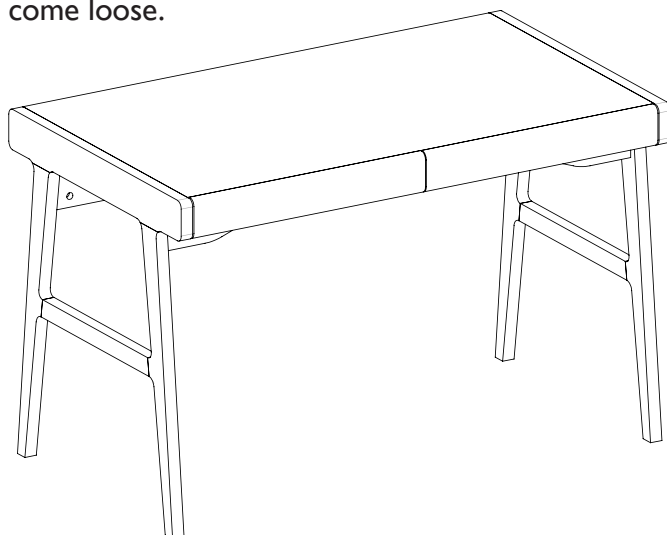
With 2 people, carefully turn the product over and place it in position, as shown below.



When using this product, we advise applying the felt pads (Part H) to the bottom of the legs to prevent damage to the floor and the product.



Note: carefully turn the product so it is upright ensuring that the drawers do not come loose.



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## Care and Maintenance

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### Wood furniture

- Wood displays different grain patterns depending on how it is cut. For example, the ‘medullary rays’ that can appear are a mark of good-quality timber. These are simply characteristics of the natural beauty of the wood. Some furniture is also deliberately aged and given a rustic finish.
- Wood veneers also allow distinctive patterns to be created on flat surfaces, such as table tops and drawer fronts by the way the slivers are arranged.
- All timber surfaces will change colour and mellow over time. New furniture will initially vary in shade from items that have been previously purchased.

### How to care for your wood furniture

- Furniture with a hard lacquer, wax polish or painted surface should be dusted with a dry cloth.
- Spray polishes are best avoided as they contain silicones which may spoil the furniture’s surface by building up over time.
- Make sure all surfaces are protected from heat and liquids by mats and coasters. Avoid placing plant pots or vases without waterproof mats to prolong the life of this product. Wipe up spills immediately and ensure that a mat or pad is placed under paper if you are writing.
- Our furniture will endure most temperatures in the home but it is best to avoid placing furniture next to heat sources such as radiators or fires. Be particularly careful with solid wood as the lack of humidity caused by central heating can cause damage such as warping.

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## Safety instructions

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- Never drag furniture when moving it, always lift it.
- Do not sit or stand upon this product.
- Periodically check all fixings to ensure none have come loose and re-tighten where necessary.
- Please take care when handling or moving the furniture, careless handling may cause damage or injury.
- Furniture can be dangerous if incorrectly installed. Assembly should be carried out by a competent person. No liability will be accepted for damage or injury caused by incorrectly installed or assembled furniture.
- It is recommended that before moving heavy objects to a new location they are completely disassembled to avoid personal injury or damage to the furniture. Please be careful to retain all fittings when doing this.

### **PLEASE READ!**

**This veneered product has a natural open grain finish. Please read the care guide thoroughly. We recommend using mats and wiping up spilled liquids immediately. Avoid placing plant pots or vases without waterproof mats to prolong the life of this product.**
